- III. **Personal Security;** concerns mental and physical health, safety and welfare.
- IV. **Livelihood Security;** concerns basic human needs such as food, shelter, subsistence and economic opportunities.

Applications are open to all Gulu University staffs who are on PhD studies, Masters programmes, Collaborative Researches and have completed their research work. Slots are available to Non - Gulu University staffs on PhD and Masters programmes, have completed their research work and are registered students at Gulu University. Five (5) slots are also available to researchers who are not affiliated to Gulu University. A total of twenty six (26) presentations will be shortlisted for the conference.

All presentations must be relevant to the themes of the conference. Our reviewers will advise on which theme your research will be catergorised under. You will be informed accordingly.

Confirmation of participation with an abstract (between 230 - 250 words) should be submitted to us latest 20th March 2013. You will be notified on the status of your application by 24th March 2013, and if successful, you will be required to submit to us a PowerPoint presentation by 29th March 2013.
